** CITIA-SC is a program of Health Sciences South Carolina and is part of a national effort to establish a network of Health Information Technology Regional Extension Centers (RECs). CITIA-SC initially is supported by a cooperative agreement with the Federal Department of Health and Human Services. RECs will offer technical assistance, guidance, and information on best practices to support and accelerate the efforts of healthcare professionals to become meaningful users of EHRs and facilitate their ability to receive Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement incentives in future years.*

CITIA-SC is primarily designed to assist with the selection, adoption, and meaningful use of electronic health records by primary care providers serving rural and underserved areas statewide.
